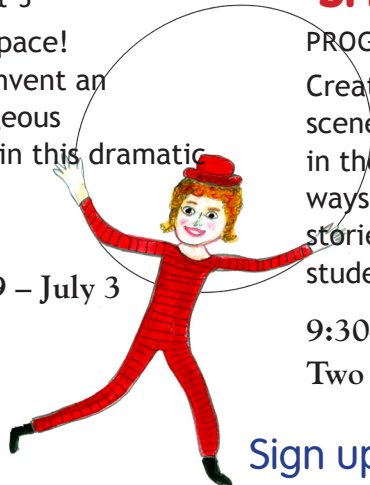
OUT OF THIS WORLD DRAMA!
